

## Moorland Group Weekend Away 2015

Area: Southern Snowdonia based around Dolgellau and Penmaenpool.

Date: 15<sup>th</sup> May to 17<sup>th</sup> May

Walk 1: Mawddach Estuary.

Start: MorfaMawddach Station. SH 628 141

Distance: 11.5 miles Time: 10.00

Route: Mawddach Trail, Hafod-dywyll, LlynauCregenau and Waterfalls.

This walk includes an estuary with views of Barmouth, woodland and fields, open moorland, a lake and waterfalls.

Walk 2: CadairIddris.

Start: Car park at Ty-nant. SH 698 152

Distance: 8 miles Time: 10.00

Route: Pony Path, LlynGadair, Penygadair, Craig Cau, Minffordd Path, LlynCau and back on the Pony Path.

This walk is only 8 miles, but includes one steep ascent on scree and an easy steep scramble out of LlynCau. For those who wish not to do the scramble there is an easier option. The views of the CarairIddris horseshoe are stunning, and this mountain is the second most popular in Wales, after Snowdon.

Walk 3: Aran Fawddwy.

Start: Car park at Cwm Cywarch on minor road from Dinas-Mawddwy. SH 852 186

Distance: 10 miles Time: 10.00

Route: Climb up deep river valley and then gentle ascent across boggy area to Aran Fawddwy and back to Drysgol and WaunGoch.

This walk to the summit of Aran Fawddwy is one of the great walks of Snowdonia and reaches nearly 3000ft, there are views of deep valleys and rolling hills.
